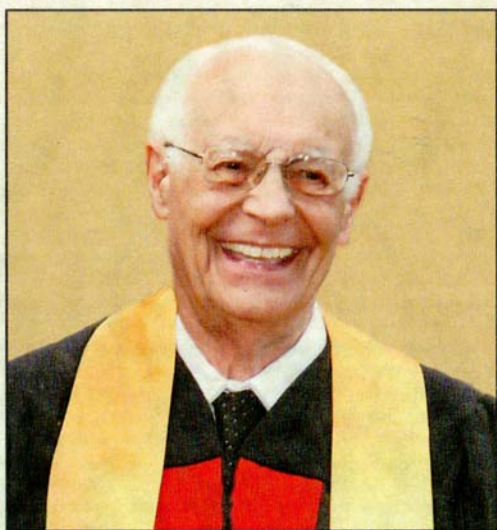

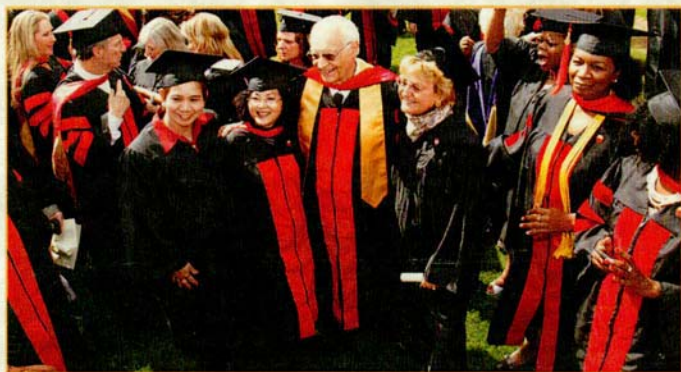


*Let There Be Peace on Earth*
